This Fourth of July is more special than others because it marks the 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence.

Several restaurants in the D-FW area will have promotions and dishes designed for the occasion.

Here are some of the best specials available over the holiday weekend, and we recommend checking the hours and terms before heading out, as some promotions are valid for just one day.
